



Lawn Primary School MFL Spanish Teaching Overview

Language Angels split their units into Early, Intermediate and Progressive Language Learning. With Early being Year 3, Intermediate Year 4-5 and Progressive Year 6. However, as part of the recovery curriculum Year 6 will complete one unit of Intermediate before moving onto Progressive.

Core Vocabulary lessons on topics such as numbers, colours and phonetics, which are mostly one-off lessons that have been planned in to help teach/recap basics.
