Lawn Primary School MFL Spanish Teaching Overview 2021/22

Language Angels split their units into Early, Intermediate and Progressive Language Learning. With Early being Year 3, Intermediate Year 4-5 and Progressive Year 6. However, as part of the recovery curriculum we will be using Early units for Year 3 and part of Year 4 and Intermediate for Years 5 and 6, with the final two topics being Progressive units for Year 6.

Core Vocabulary lessons on topics such as numbers, colours and phonetics, which are mostly one-off lessons that have been planned in to help teach/recap basics.

Grammar Explained lessons are one-off Language Angels lessons that have been planned in for Years 3-6 to deepen children's understanding of grammar in Spanish.
